

It also occurs in a ms book owned by Stephen Lade, probably from Mongeham in East Kent, and which contained mostly sacred music, The text is from Isaac Watts' *Divine Songs (for children)*, pub. 1715. The music is attributed to Jno Bayley in the Lade ms book.
