Blenham LM is taken from the Burford Bass Quire Book, post 1826, now in the custodianship of Mike Bailey and by whose kind permission it is used. It is presumed the title is a mis-spelling of Blenheim, the seat of the Duke of Marlborough, which lies but 16 miles to the east of Burford.

Although there are several tunes in the HTI under similar names, none of them remotely resemble this tune, or are of the correct metre. No text was given, other than an indication to repeat the last line of words for the final four bars. We have used the first five of the 48 verses of Psalm 106 NV on this occasion.
